Day 3 – Work on paragraph two which outlines the reason for your stance.


d Don't forget to include detail in your reason.

Day 4 − Look to add increased detail. Can you add: feelings, sensations, facts & experts or stories & details to support your argument?


Don`t forget to 'persuasive' language in your writing.

Are my ideas in the correct order? Did I tell things in the order that helps the	
reader understand the argument I am making?	
Did I start my persuasive writing with an interesting introduction that will make	
the reader want to read more about my arguments for or against my opinion?	
Will my sentences "paint a picture" in the reader's mind so that they can visualize	
exactly what my opinion is?	
Have I used interesting words that the reader will enjoy?	
Have I overused any words or phrases?	
Is my conclusion good? Does it end my piece of writing well?


