












Library News

Click and Collect Library

While school is open you can still borrow books from the Library

Log in to Student Portal and select Oliver Library.

Search for the books you want and drag them into your basket.

When you have made your selection (up to 6 books) click More Actions, then Share, then Send an email, to email me your request.

I will use the family email address to let you know when the books are ready for collection on the verandah outside the front office.

The loan period is 6 weeks (but you are very welcome to return them as soon as you want more!)

To return books, leave them in the marked tub on the verandah outside the front office. Note that Oliver Library will be unavailable 13 - 17 April (1^{st} week of the school holidays).


