### NAPLAN

NAPLAN this year will be held in Term 1 between 15 – 27 March. The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual national assessment for all students in Years 3, 5, 7, and 9, and is the only nationwide assessment that all Australian children undertake. Students will sit 4 tests – Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy during the test period. Assessments are completed online except for Year 3 Writing, who will complete their test on paper. Please keep an eye out for more information regarding NAPLAN in the upcoming weeks.


